Dear Parents/Carers,

Achievements

We are very pleased to let you know that two former pupils (Nathaniel Ould and Ben Leather) were part of the Beaminster Year 9 Public Speaking team that won the Regional final of the competition in Exmouth and will now go on to compete in the **NATIONAL FINAL** in Telford in May! Ben also took the award for Best Chairperson. We would like to congratulate them both on this fantastic achievement and wish them well for the final.

Isabella recently competed in the IDTA Nationwide Medallist of the Year finals in Blackpool. To make a dance final at this competition is the pinnacle of all amateur dancers' aspirations around the country and Isabella danced her way through seven rounds to make her ballroom final in her first year of competing in the 'Up to 12 years' category in a class with 78 competitors. After dancing all five ballroom dances one after the other in the final she was awarded seventh place.. Well done Isabella on achieving a great result at a National Final.

Izzy recently competed in the West Dorset Schools Gala (which includes some of the best swimmers in the county) and as a result has now been selected to represent West Dorset at the Dorset Schools Gala. Well done Izzy.

Important - Play Structure Supervision After School

Can I just remind you that outside of school hours you are responsible for ensuring your child is supervised whilst using the school play structure and that it is not the School's responsibility. This is obviously a challenging piece of equipment for some children and we have already seen a few accidents when the children have not been supervised and we would like to ensure that this does not happen in the future. We cannot guarantee that there will be a qualified first aider on site to help with children's injuries.

Important – Parking at the start and end of the day

To ensure the safety of all children and road users, and also out of respect for our neighbours, please DO NOT stop in the driveway of the house opposite school or on the Keep Clear signs outside the gate. Doing so presents a risk to the children due to lack of visibility and can cause traffic problems. We have had some near misses recently and I am sure that no one would want to be responsible for a child being hurt. It may take you a little longer, but will avoid potential accidents and chaos at this busy time of day.



The school bus stop should also not be used for dropping off and picking children up between 8.25 and 8.45am and 2.45 to 3.15pm. The bus stop is to ensure the safety of the children who catch the school bus to and from school and should not be used by parents at this could put the bus children in danger and also cause chaos in the road outside of school.
