Lexia

Lexia is a fantastic reading programme with a proven track record of developing both word recognition and reading comprehension skills. In order for progress to be made, it is recommended that children spend a minimum of 40 minutes per week working through the activities.

If your child is registered to use Lexia, please could you ensure that they are using it for at least one 20 minute session per week at home. The more time spent, the quicker your child will progress.

If you have any difficulties with internet access at home or access to the Lexia program specifically, please contact your class teacher either in person or via their email address (see homework folder). Otherwise, we will assume that all of the children are able to complete the required time as part of their home learning.

Uniform

Our uniform is a part of encouraging the children to take pride in themselves and our school. Could you please ensure that children are tidy and presentable by wearing the correct uniform. When this has been addressed previously we have noticed an improved attitude to learning and their school work. If you meet the requirements and you successfully apply for means tested free school meals the school will provide basic school uniform.

The uniform is a royal blue polo shirt with grey trousers or skirt and dark blue sweatshirt or cardigan. The girls may wear a blue and white checked dress in the summer.

Proper shoes must be worn and trainers, boots or highly decorative shoes are not allowed with school uniform please.

Long hair (from shoulder length) is to worn up, but decorative hair adornments are not allowed. The only jewellery item permitted is small plain studs.

Uniform may be purchased at Tesco by following these easy steps:

- Select your school from the list and you will see all the customised items that you can buy
- Choose the quantity and sizes you'd like and add them to your basket
- Pay with debit or credit card at the checkout (you earn Clubcard points as well)
- Your embroidered items will be delivered within 14 days

Uniform may still be purchased directly from the school office, but due to the cost will be £1.50 per item more expensive than uniform purchased from Tescos.

All children in KS2 must wear trainers for PE as Daps are not suitable or safe footwear for the type of PE that the children participate in at this stage.

The optional hoodies for PE are supplied by a different company and have to be ordered through school at a cost of £10. Please contact the office if you would like to order any for your child/children.
