Lateness and attendance

We have recently been visited by the Dorset County Council Attendance Officer regarding the new procedures that are in the process of being agreed. Schools are going to have termly visits from the officer to check attendance for all pupils in school to identify children who may need support to improve their attendance. Persistent absence, regular patterns of absence and regular lateness are very likely to flag up further action by the officer.

We understand that it is Dorset County Council's intention to start issuing fines for term time holidays in the near future. We feel it best that it's best to inform you now so that you can consider this when booking any future holidays. We do not have any other information at the moment but will update you once we know more.

Lateness is also included as an unauthorised absence and recorded on our attendance registers. If you do need to fill in the late book in the foyer please be mindful that the County Attendance Officer will be monitoring this and reasons for lateness should be valid. If your child is continually late then further action may be taken
