A teacher will then blow the whistle and we would like all parents to leave the playground so that the children can line up without any distractions. 
We would greatly appreciate your cooperation with this and can assure you that the playground will be checked for any forgotten items once the children have been taken to their classes.

At the end of the day!

School closes at 3.00pm everyday with the exception of clubs. We are having an increasing amount of children coming into school after this time to use the toilets and look for lost items. We understand that this is necessary but after half term the school will only be accessible to parents/children until 3.10pm.

The school is not set up to supervise children after school hours and health and safety would require some supervision to be in place which we do not have the staff for. As well as, this staff use the time after school to catch up on any events that have occurred during the day and some of the information discussed is sensitive therefore, parents/children should not be in school to hear this.

We would be grateful if you could respect this change as it will also enable staff to catch up on marking and preparation for the next day and this takes much longer if they are being continually disrupted.



Eschools and Letters

We have now been using Eschools for other six months to send out electronic copies of all letters which should have given you all a chance to go into the website and look at the activities happening in your child's class as well as copies of the letters we have sent home.

To help cut back on the amount of paper being sent home we will now only be sending electronic copies of information letters however, any letter that requires a response will also be sent home as a hard copy. To see any letters that have been sent home you can login to the school website www.sticklands.dorset.sch.uk using the "login" box in the top right of the home page. If for some reason you have lost your username it will always be your firstname.surname ie. lisa.cracknell and there is a button for forgotten password.

If you download the "eschools" app onto your phone or tablet this will notify you of any letters sent to you.

We also spend an awful lot of time chasing reply slips for the children therefore, we are now implementing a policy to stop this. You will receive a hard copy of the letter with the permission slip, at the same time the letter is emailed to you. We will then send you an email followed by a text to remind you to return the slip if you have not already done so. If you do not return the slip then your child will not be able to attend the event.

Finally, if for some reason you do need a hard copy of any information letters then please contact the office.

Key Stage Two Melbury House Concert – 7th and 8th December

The Key Stage Two choir will be performing a concert of lessons and carols in the library at Melbury House, with the Melbury Team Choir and local musicians. This promises to be a very special event once again. The concert will be from 6.30pm to approximately 8.00pm and is a ticketed event, £2.50 for adults, children are free. Refreshments will be available and there will be a luxurious hamper raffle on both nights. All proceeds will go towards FOSSA funds which contributes to many of the extra special activities that the children do throughout the year. Tickets will be available from the school office and the Evershot shop nearer the time.

Should a child not show commitment or their behaviour is unacceptable then we will write to you and their place will be offered to another child.

Finally, I am sure you are all aware that the staff provide these clubs during their own time and we would therefore be grateful if you could collect your child promptly at the end of these clubs.
