End of Year Reports to Parents – Friday 14th July.

Universal Infant Free School Meals

You will be aware that all children under the age of 7 years i.e. those children in the infants, are entitled to a free meal paid for by the Government. As soon as a child reaches Y3 this entitlement ceases. Therefore, for our rising Y3s i.e. those children currently in Y2, you will need to let Mrs Shepherd know if you require a meal for your child in September. There has been only limited response to a letter already sent home to all Y2 parents that covers this issue. If you do not confirm that you wish your child to have a meal in September, they will need to be provided with a packed lunch. The cost for hot meals the first half term is £76.50, with cheques made payable to Birmingham City Council.
