

# The Breakfast Club Trial - FAQ

## **Introduction**

As mentioned previously the breakfast club will operate on a trial basis, we hope it's a success and much of that depends on the take up rate. Most schools have at least 200+ pupils which provides enough demand to run a breakfast club and keep the fees reasonable, at Dropmore school we will have the same set up and running costs as other schools but without the same demand, that's why the fees are slightly higher. However, as this is a trial (in every sense) we will be reviewing fees so it is possible they could go down.

## **When does the trial start and for how long?**

The breakfast club is for Dropmore Infant School pupils only (this will be reviewed after the trial) and will open from 7.30am, we will walk the children over to the school playground at 8.30am. Last breakfast will be served at 8.15am:

- Next week for 3 days only Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday (19th - 21st March)
- Full week - 25th to 29th March
- Full week - 1st April - 5th April

## **Where will The Breakfast Club take place?**

St Anne's Church, across the road from the school. There is an area in the church that is ideal. There is also a small kitchen and toilet facilities.

## **How do I book a regular session?**

Please hand in (or scan and email) your registration forms and email us your required day(s), this will secure your sessions permanently.

## **How do I book an ad hoc session?**

Please hand in (or scan and email) your registration forms and please email us your required day(s).

## **How do I book a last minute session?**

Please hand in (or scan and email) your registration forms and ideally email us by 8pm the previous evening. However, we must have your completed registrations in order for us to care for your child.

## **How much does it cost?**

To qualify for a prepay rate, please ensure payment for the week ahead has been transferred to our account. If payment has not been received, we will send an invoice for the higher rate.
