

Communication & Language

The children will continue to develop their confidence to speak in a familiar group, talk about their ideas and to listen respectfully to others. They will also develop these skills in our Role play area. Year R can continue to bring an item to show and tell on a Friday.

Expressive Art and Design

We will be studying artists who use Space as an inspiration for their paintings and then we will recreate their styles using different media.

Physical Development

The children will be doing netball and football skills in their PE lessons with Mr Studd. We will also be developing our movement and space awareness skills through Dance and Gymnastics.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be learning how to co-operate and take turns with others and form positive relationships with adults and the other children in our class. Our Values for Life themes are **Wisdom** and **Perseverance** .

Mathematics

- Number - read, write, say and locate 2 digit numbers on a 100 square and understand place value. Revise number bonds to 10 and solve + and - word problems. Begin to count in 2s 5s and 10s.
- Shape, space and measures - 3D shapes, telling the time and the months and seasons of the year.

The Deep

English

The children will continue to develop their phonic knowledge to use in their reading and own writing. We will be exploring fiction and non-fiction texts, including Fantasy stories ,Riddles and Questions and Instructions. The children will focus on punctuating and extending their writing.

Understanding the World

History & Geography:

We will be developing our historical and geographical skills through the topic of the Moon. We will find out about the phases of the moon and learn about the first moon landing.

Science:

The children will be learning about materials. They will be naming, identifying and comparing everyday materials. We will also be learning to understand why materials are chosen for their specific properties.

ICT:

The children will be using a range of technology (bee-bots, netbooks, iPads, cameras etc) to create work in different curriculum areas. They will be learning that we need precise instructions to get technology to work and that e safety is very important.

R.E:

This year in R.E we will focus on Christianity and Hinduism. In the Spring term we will explore two questions, Creation: Who made the world ? and Why does Easter matter to Christians?
