

Communication & Language

The children will be developing their confidence to speak in a familiar group, talk about their ideas and to listen respectfully to others. Year R will start sharing their speaking and listening folders with the class on a weekly basis.

Expressive Art and Design

We will be linking our art and design to the whole school topic, Disasters and Triumphs. We will be using a range of media and techniques to create pictures and 3D items.

Physical Development

The children will learn to master basic physical movements in Dance, Gymnastics and Games. They will work individually, in pairs and as a team.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be learning how to co-operate and take turns with others and form positive relationships with new adults and the other children in our class. Our Values for Life themes this term are **Generosity** and **Respect**.

Mathematics

- Number – place value, addition and subtraction of numbers, knowing pairs to 10/20 and doubling numbers.
- Measurement- estimate and measure length, using non- standard and standard units. 2D shapes, position and direction. EYFS- Developing experiences of using number and everyday mathematical language.

Disasters and Triumphs

English

The children will begin to develop their phonic knowledge in Letters and Sounds to use in their reading and own writing. We will be focusing on information texts, using these to produce labels, signs and lists. We will also be exploring fiction stories with familiar settings and repeating patterns and traditional poetry with pattern and rhyme.

Understanding the World

History & Geography: We will be developing our historical and geographical skills through the topic, Disasters and Triumphs. We will focus on Wrecks and Rescues, learning about lighthouses and lifeboats and people in the past who played significant roles in rescues.

Science:

The children will be learning about the human body, including food and healthy eating. They will be looking at living things and their habitats and discussing Seasonal changes.

ICT:

Children will be using a range of technology to create work in different curriculum areas. Children will also be learning that we need precise instructions to get technology to work and that safety is very important.

R.E:

This year in R.E we will focus on Christianity and Hinduism. In the Autumn term we will explore topics including Myself, Special stories and books and Religious celebrations.
