

## Communication & Language

The children will continue to develop their confidence to speak in a familiar group, talk about their ideas and listen respectfully to others. Year R will continue their Show and tell time on a Friday afternoon.

## Expressive Art and Design

We will be focusing on our skills and techniques this term. The children will study animal prints and then design their own print.

## Physical Development

In P.E we will be developing throwing, catching and movement skills through Rugby, Cricket and Athletics. We will also be attending our KS1 Sports Day. Weekly swimming lessons will be taking place on Tuesday afternoons for 6 weeks.

## Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be learning how to co-operate, take turns with others and form positive relationships. Our Values for Life themes this term are **Friendship** and **Respect**.

## Mathematics

Number - Locate, order and identify numbers to 100. Identify 10s and 1s in 2 digit numbers. Add 3 small numbers and spot pairs and doubles. Recognise odd and even numbers and count in 2s 5s and 10s. Measurement- read the time to the half hour and quarter hour. Compare Weights and Capacity. Complete tables and Block graphs and focus on 2D Shape and pattern.

## English

This term, we will be focusing on stories by the same author, stories about feelings, Non chronological reports, letters, postcards and Nonsense and Action Poems. Reception children will also be aiming to write a sentence independently! We will be focusing on spelling, punctuation and grammar in our writing tasks.

## Understanding the World

### History & Geography:

The children will attend a Forest School at Poltesco and observe features of the local environment. They will then study animals from different parts of the world and their habitats.

### Science:

Children will be learning about Plants, identifying, naming and grouping them. They will find out what conditions they need to grow and how seeds are dispersed. They will also learn about Light and Shadows in the second half term and Year 2 will focus on Sound and how it is created.

### ICT:

Children will be using a range of technology to create work in different curriculum areas. They will also be learning that we need precise instructions to get technology to work and that safety is important.

### R.E:

This year in R.E we will focus on Christianity and Hinduism. In the Summer term we will explore two main questions :What is the Good News Jesus brings ? and Why is Cornwall a Spiritual and Religious place ?
