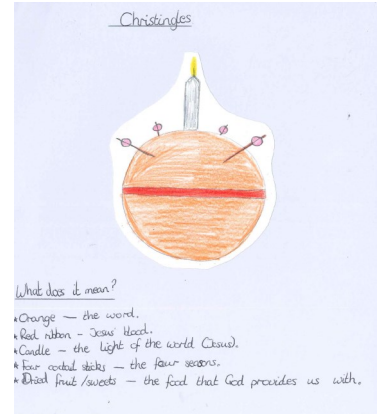

Save the Children Christmas Jumper Day

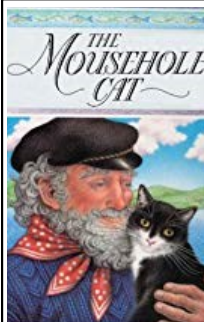
