

## Report on Sports Premium spending 2016/17

<b>£1000</b>	<b>Curriculum dance / teacher CPD (R&amp;B dance)</b>	The children in all year groups had professional dance teaching enabling them to achieve well and gain maximum enjoyment. Teachers will benefit from the CPD they receive by also being involved in the series of lessons for their class.
<b>£472</b>	<b>Sports Competitions. 16/17</b>	Children will have opportunities to take part in competitive sport as these arise throughout the year.
<b>£2235</b>	<b>Afterschool Sports coaching (SCS) Sept 2016 – July 2017</b>	Year groups will benefit from professionally run sports clubs increasing enjoyment and participation in sport. Various sports to be offered over the year to include children in Yr 1 – Yr 6. (2 clubs per week all year.)
<b>£200</b>	<b>Cricket club (spring 2017)</b>	Sussex Cricket board to be invited to run after school clubs for KS2. This enable children to be trained by qualified coaches, which enriched the experience for the children. This was very successful in 2015/16.
<b>£228</b>	<b>Tennis (spring 2017)</b>	Chichester Tennis club to be invited to run an after school tennis clubs, giving high quality coaching to encourage continuing engagement.
<b>£287</b>	<b>Gymnastics equipment Footballs and play equipment</b>	New footballs and other play equipment were purchased to encourage activity at playtime.
<b>£1080</b>	<b>Archery (summer 2016)</b>	Afterschool club to extend children's experience of a different sport
<b>£1018</b>	<b>KTROO (May 2016)</b>	Afterschool club to extend children's experience of a different activity
<b>£2950</b>	<b>Forest schools</b>	To give children OAA activities led by a fully qualified leader.
