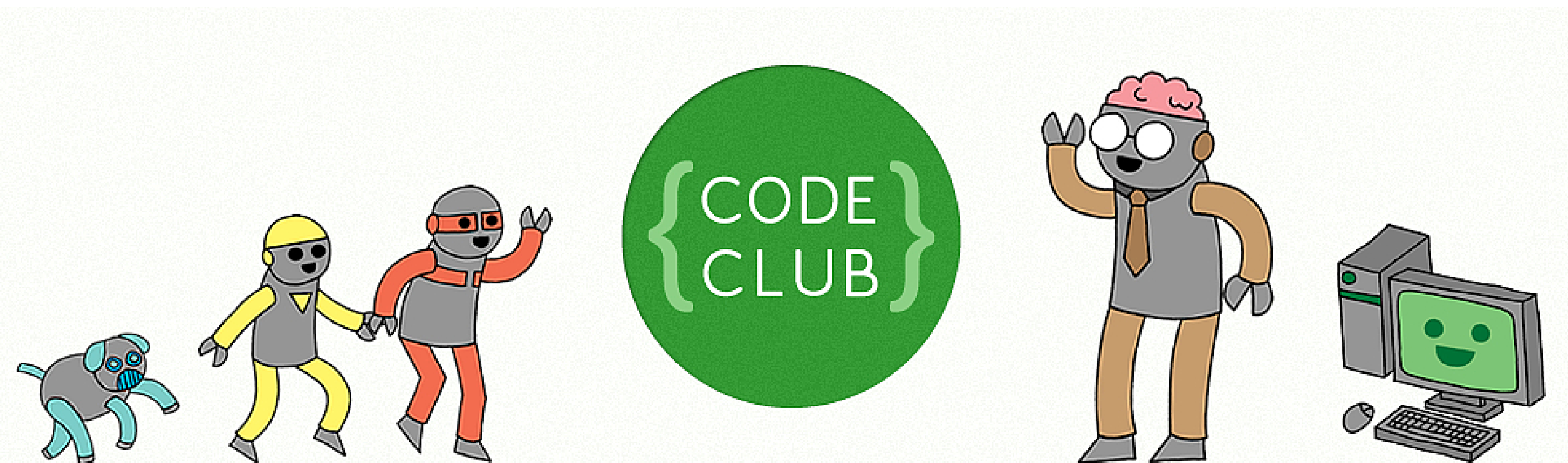

Come along and find out more about these fun and rewarding volunteering opportunities at one of our informal sessions. A friendly welcome and refreshments will be provided:

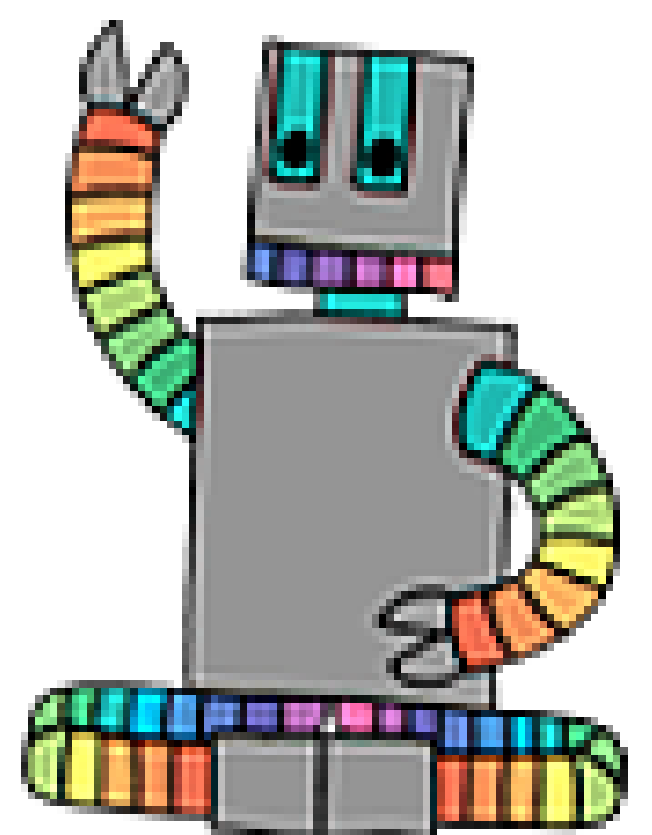

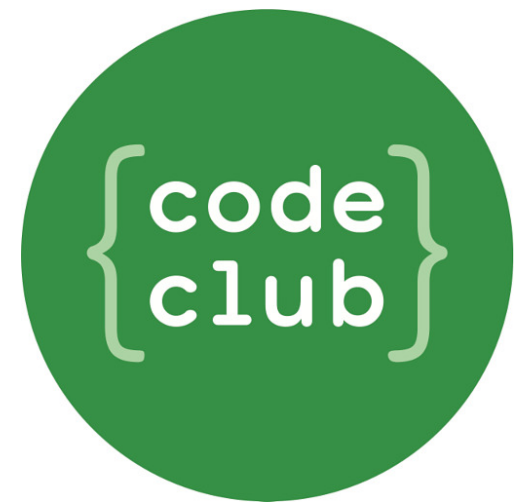

Code Club provide step-by-step activity sheets for the children to follow so they can create games, animations and websites, learning the key concepts of programming at the same time.

Code Club resources teach children Scratch, HTML/CSS and Python.
