

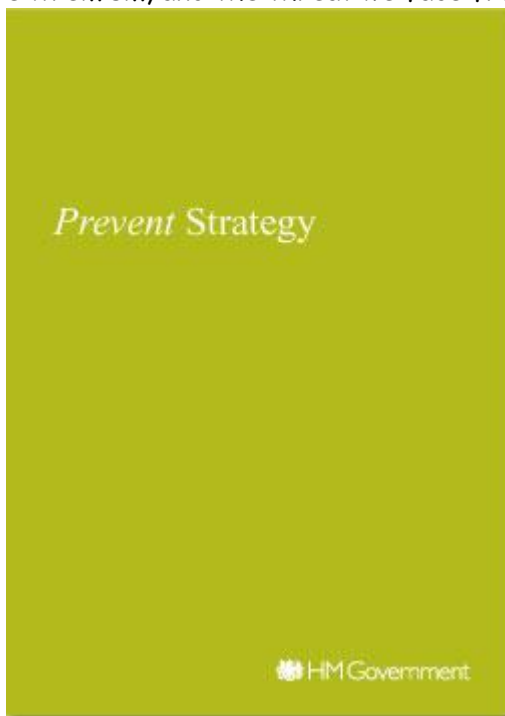
# Prevent Strategy

As part of St Pauls with St Michaels commitment to safeguarding and child protection we fully support the government's *Prevent Strategy*, and take guidance from *Teaching Approaches to help build resilience to extremism*.

## What is the Prevent Strategy?

The Prevent strategy is a government strategy designed to stop people becoming terrorists or supporting terrorism. It:

- responds to the ideological challenge we face from terrorism and aspects of extremism, and the threat we face from those who promote these views



- provides practical help to prevent people from being drawn into terrorism and ensure they are given appropriate advice and support
- works with a wide range of sectors (including education, criminal justice, faith, charities, online and health)
- At St Pauls with St Michaels we promote British Values as part of our cycle of pastoral care through assembly and worship. We organise British Values week every January to celebrate this with the whole community.
