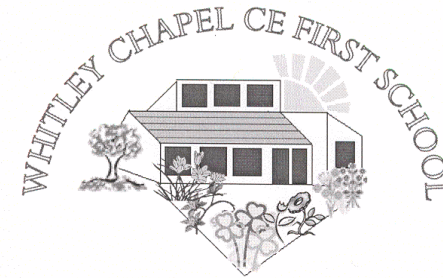
I will:
