Home-School Agreement

The purpose of the home-school agreement is to formalise the key responsibilities that parents have towards supporting the school and their child and the provision that the school puts in place to work in partnership. - ensure my child is not accessing any inappropriate material (e.g. computer games, internet sites/social media or TV programs that are not suitable for their age.
