## 'Go Ahead'

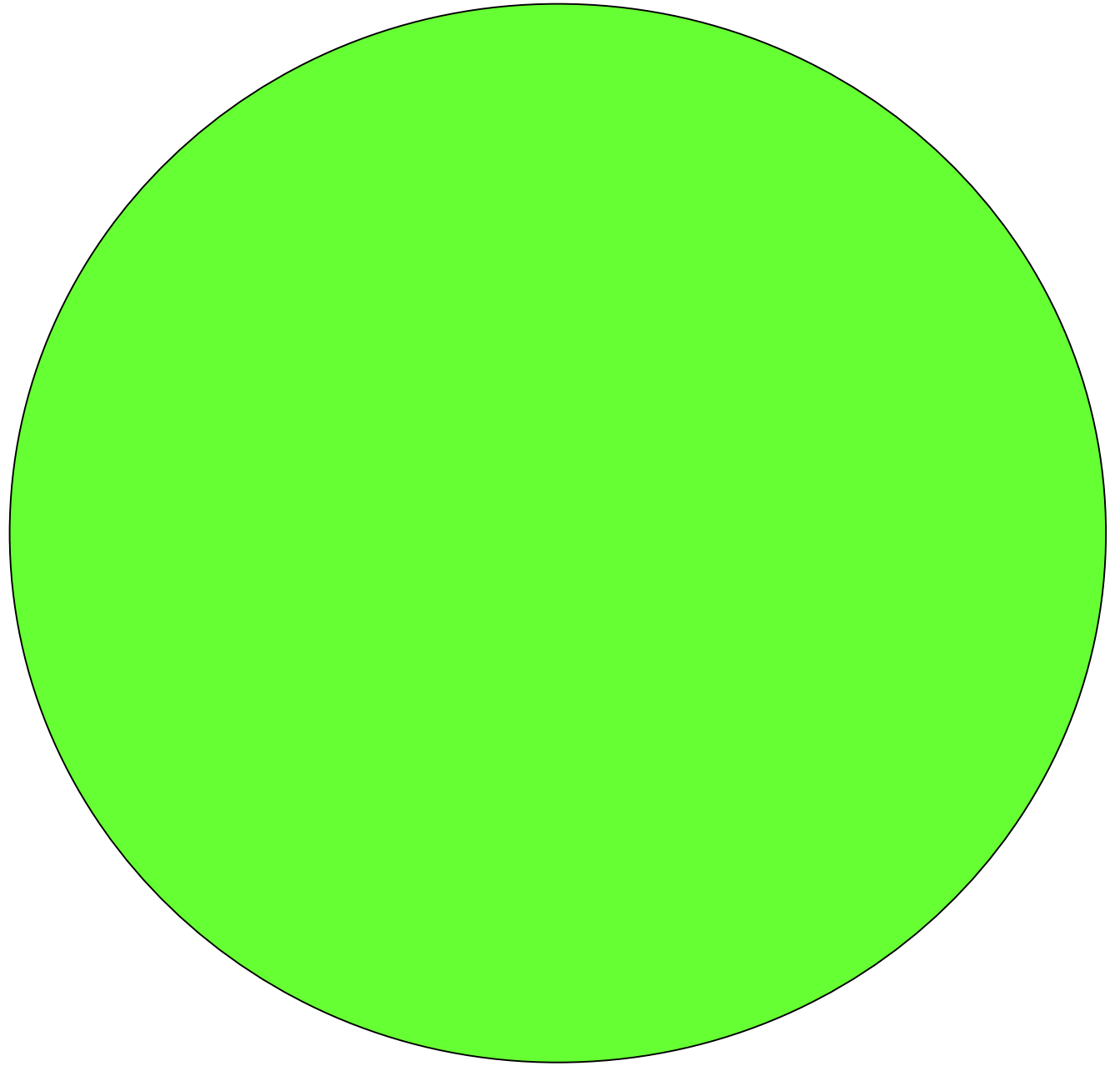
This is what we want to see in our school.

### **Consequences:**

- Your name will stay on the green traffic light.
- You will be able to learn and help others to do the same. This will help you have a safe, happy and productive time at school.

1. Listen carefully.
2. Do as you are asked by an adult first time.
3. Always try your best and help others to do the same.
4. Be polite, fair and kind to others.
5. Walk around school sensibly, quietly and calmly.
6. Treat others' property and the school environment carefully.
7. Tell the truth.
8. Be respectful during assemblies and special reflective time.

# Yellow Behaviour

## 'Take Care!'

This behaviour is **not what we want to see** in our school.

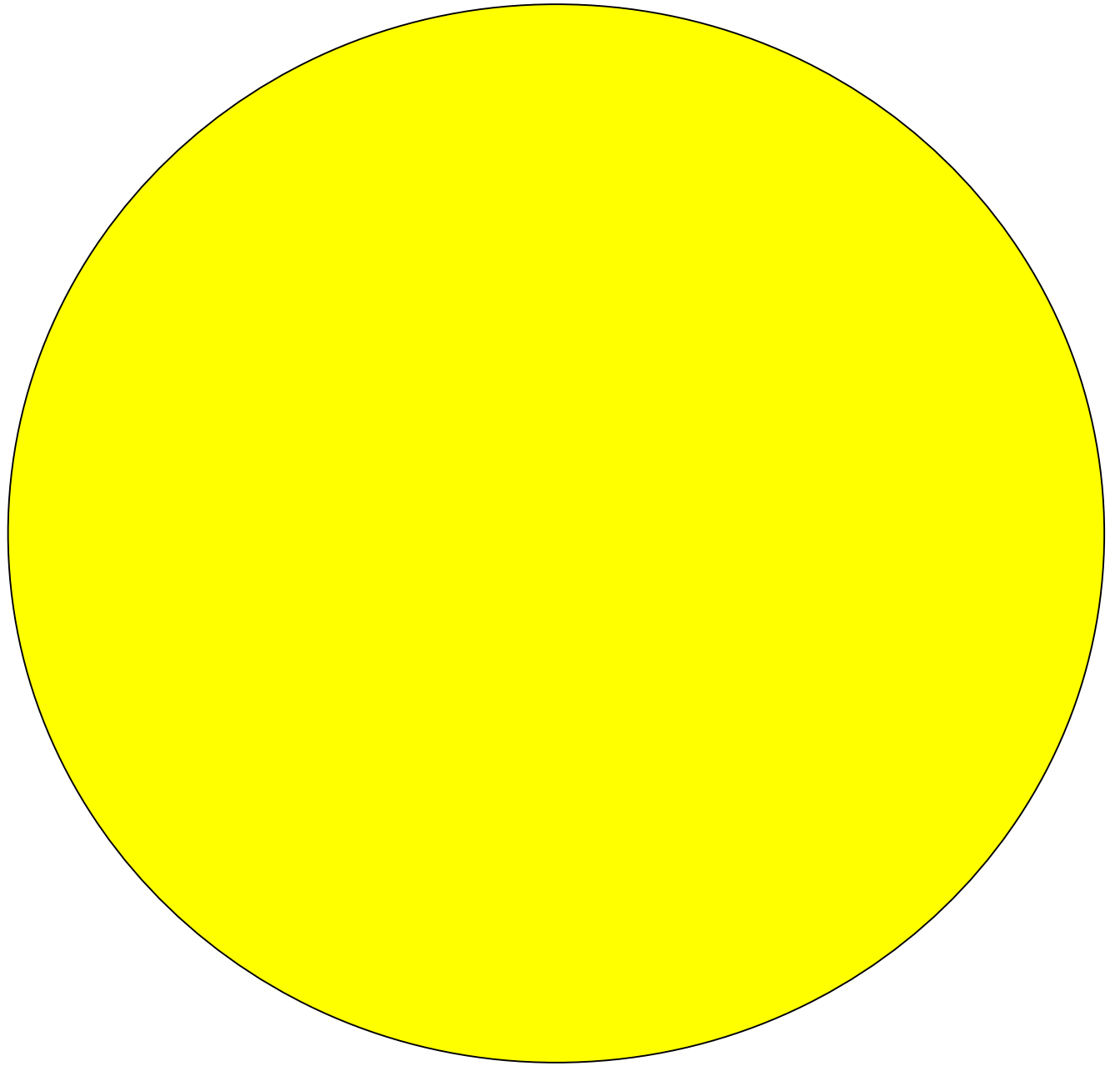
### **Consequences:**

- Your name will be taken off the green traffic light.
- You will be reminded that your behaviour is not acceptable and the rule that you have broken.
- It could mean that you are given time to reflect or you may miss a playtime.

1. Telling lies.
2. Physically hurting others e.g. shoving, pushing.
3. Saying unkind things or calling names.
4. Running in school (except during PE) and being inconsiderate in shared spaces.
5. Stopping others from learning.
6. Not treating the property of others or the school environment carefully.
7. Not listening, interrupting or talking over an adult.
8. Being disruptive in assembly or special reflective time.

Take care! This behaviour is **not what we want to see** in our school.



# Red Behaviour

## 'Stop!'

This is **unacceptable** in our school.

### **Consequences:**

- **You will definitely need to have time to reflect away from classroom and you may miss a playtime or some of lunch time.**
- Your name will be removed from the green traffic light.
- The Head Teacher, Deputy, or Assistant Head Teacher will need to talk to you.
- This serious behaviour will be recorded.
- Your teacher will contact your parents and let them know.
- You may miss out on further privileges in school.
- You may need to spend some of the day working away from your class.

1. Refusing to follow an adult's instructions, arguing back or rudeness.
2. Deliberately hurting someone e.g. hitting, punching, kicking.
3. Swearing.
4. Bullying.
5. Stealing.
6. Deliberately breaking or damaging the property of others or the school environment.
7. Intolerant behaviour.
8. Being consistently disruptive in class, assemblies or special reflective time.
