- Develop social phrases
- Engage in non-fiction books

Physical Development

- Move in different ways
- Combine different movements
- Patterns of movement related to dance
- Develop overall body strength, balance, co-ordination and agility
- Use a knife and fork for eating
- Develop letter formation and handwriting style
- Healthy eating

Literacy

- Engage in conversations about stories
- Blend sounds into words
- Read and write Tricky Words from Phase 2 and 3 (Letters and Sounds)
- Read simple phrases and sentences
- Form lower-case and some capital letters correctly
- Re-read books to build up fluency
- Use Phonic skills to help with spelling words
- Talk for Writing - Story Maps and short sentences using a capital letter and full stop

Mathematics

- Count objects, actions and sounds
- Subitise numbers to 5
- Understand the 'one more/one less' relationship
- Recall number bonds for numbers 0 - 10
- Select, rotate and manipulate shapes in order to develop spatial reasoning skills
- Continue, copy and create repeating patterns

Understanding the World

- Understand the effect of the changing seasons
- Compare and contrast characters from stories, including figures from the past
- Explore the natural world around them
- Compare environments
- Comment on images of familiar situations in the past
