Andy Goldsworthy

This half term, we will be finding out about the artist Andy Goldsworthy and making a land art sculpture from natural materials.



P.E

Ball Games

In PE, we will develop basic movements including running, jumping, throwing and catching and apply these into games.



Maths

Multiplication and Division, Fractions, Shape

This half term, we will learn to:

- Count in multiples of two, five and ten.
- Solve one step problems involving multiplication and division, by calculating the answer using concrete objects, pictorial representations and arrays.
- Recognise, find and name a half as one of two equal parts of an object, shape or quantity.
- Recognise, find and name a quarter as one of four equal parts of an object.

Literacy

Traditional Tales and Fairy Tales

Talk for Writing – Little Red Riding Hood
We will be writing our own version of this traditional tale.

Explanation texts

The children will be creating an explanation text on the suitability of different materials for a purpose.

History

Who helps to keep us safe?


We will be learning about the different people in our community who keep us safe.
