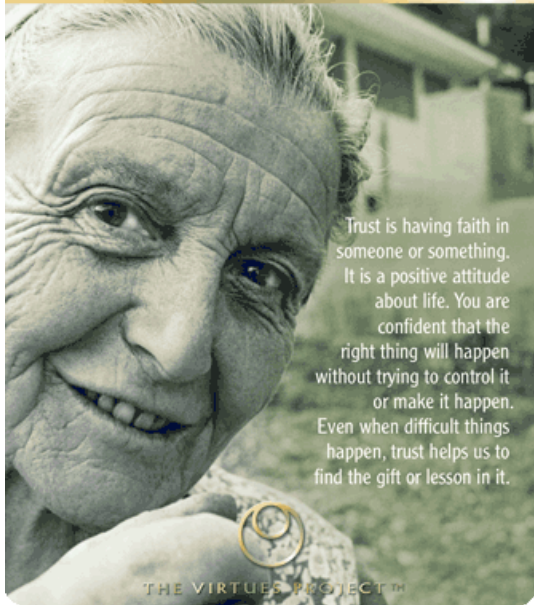

Foundation stage

This week the classes will be focusing on the jobs people do and how they help us. We welcome any parents who would like to come in and talk to the children about their jobs. In maths children will be finding one less with numbers to 10.

In phonics the new sounds are 'ow' and 'oi'. Please also encourage your child to practise their tricky words at home and look for the new sounds in their reading books.

Key Stage 1 Our new topic is 'Global Gardens'. We are looking forward to a week of music and completing body percussion—ask any one of the children at the end of the week and they should be

able to show you!

Later this term the children will be planting vegetables. Please can you send any 1 ltr water / fizzy drink bottles to Mrs Figgins so that they can recycle them as plant pots.

Key Stage 2

Swordfish and Emperor fish classes will be starting their new topic on the Anglo Saxons this week. Also in RE they have been learning the people of Jerusalem changed their view of Jesus. In literacy the classes will be writing character descriptions based upon mythical creatures and monsters.

For children in year in year 5 this week they will be learning a traditional Cornish dance that they will be performing on the Harbour head next week on St Piran's Day Tuesday 5th March. Parents and other family members are very welcome to attend the ceremonies next Tuesday at 10.00am.

Our topic in Years 5&6 this half term is Ang Gof, where children will be learning about the Cornish rebellion of 1497. The unit involves a lot of drama to immerse the children into what it was like to be living in Cornwall at that time.
