Average Point Score 2014 and 2015 SATS results)

- The 'Key Stage 2 average point score per pupil' performance measure shows the total number of points achieved in each subject by all eligible pupils, divided by the number of eligible pupils. The average point score that a child is expected to get at the end of year 6 (KS2) is 27 points. This equates to a 4b which is the national expected level. Level 5, above national expectation, starts at 5c or 31 points.

Scaled Score

Scaled scores replaced levels in 2016. To meet government expectations, pupils must achieve 100 in their scaled scores.
