Closure for Polling on the 7th May 2020

We have been talking to Plymouth City Council about finding a compromise to closing the school for polling days as we are aware of how disruptive it is for you as parents, the children and the school. We have been informed by the council today that they will require use of the school on the 7th May, but that they are investigating other options for future elections. Therefore, **WE WILL BE CLOSED FOR THE LOCAL ELECTIONS ON THE 7th MAY 2020**. I was hoping to share a different outcome but feel positive that a compromise will be reached for the future.
