Mornings: To ensure children are in their classes on time in the mornings we have decided to blow a whistle at 8.50am each morning to indicate that children need to come off the large play equipment. Sickness: We have been alerted by Public health England that norovirus is prevalent again and we have had our fair share of D&V at school over the Autumn **school! In** the light of this we need to be extra vigilant about ensuring children do not return to school until 48 hours after their last bout of D&V and that we all wash hands thoroughly throughout the day.

The Plympton Hub: At the end of this newsletter I have added a flyer for events that are happening at the Hub in January. These sessions are well worth signing up to.

Parking around the school: As ever we have had complaints from neighbours and parents about the thoughtless and dangerous parking of some of our parents. Despite numerous attempts to remind people that we are keeping **your** children safe when asking for safer parking, we still have people parking on the zig-zag lines outside the school gate and on the pavements around Nash Close. I have now contacted the police and they will be making random visits to the site to ticket all drivers who are parking dangerously and breaking the law. **Please stop!**

Foundation Unit: Work is continuing on the new Foundation Unit and the completion date is still February half-term. The foundations and base structure have been laid and built and so we are waiting with excitement as the walls begin to be assembled from this week.
