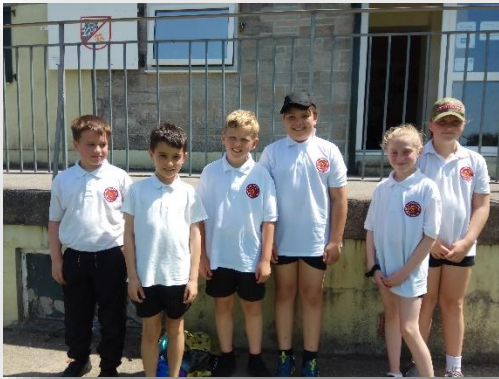


\* Year 3 went on a brilliant trip to the Moor, Cadover Bridge and then took a boat tour around the Sound.
