Attendance

As you are probably aware attendance at school is closely monitored by the Government. This means that the County Attendance Officer visits schools to check registers and attendance data. We have just had our visit, our whole school attendance is currently at 96.1%, which is above the national average of 95% but does remain a focus.

Some individual attendance has dropped below 90%, which we have been advised that we have a duty to monitor. In order to monitor this, individual letters will be coming home by the end of term for those where attendance has dropped below 90%.

You may be interested to know that the Government class attendance at 90% or below as a 'persistent absence', attendance between 90 – 95% they consider a concern.

Thankfully, we are coming into Spring where hopefully we will begin to see the coughs, colds and tummy upsets that seem so rife during the winter months disappearing, which should see an improvement in attendance.
