For all pupils we provide

Thinking, Understanding and Learning

- ◆ First class teaching, including differentiated learning opportunities.
- ◆ A range of visual, auditory and kinaesthetic teaching styles and learning opportunities.
- ◆ Ongoing feedback and assessment including pink/green marking, self-review, peer-review, target setting.
- ◆ Resources available for children to access during independent work e.g. working walls for maths and english, steps to success, physical maths resources such as number lines, pencil grips, reading rulers, fidget gadgets.
- ◆ Access to technology e.g. i-pads.
- ◆ Reading support -
 - YR to Y2 1:1 reading at least weekly
 - Guided group reading weekly
- ◆ TA or HLTA support for group working across all abilities - all classes where required.

Speech Language and Communication

- ◆ Whole class visual timetable.
- ◆ Active, co-operative learning opportunities across the school throughout the day.
- ◆ Opportunities to present work to class.
- ◆ Speaking, reading or performing at events such as assemblies, masses, plays and productions etc.
- ◆ School Council.
- ◆ Fundraising for charities and PTFA events.
- ◆ Educational visits and visitors.

Physical and Medical

- ◆ Accessible classrooms and toilets.
- ◆ Blinds and carpets for good visual and listening environments.
- ◆ Access to fresh drinking water.
- ◆ Trained first aiders and first aid training for all staff.
- ◆ School Nurse drop-in sessions.

Emotion and Behaviour

- ◆ Forest School Opportunities.
- ◆ After school clubs.
- ◆ School behaviour policy, including school values, rewards, sanctions and class contract.
- ◆ Weekly "Golden Time".
- ◆ Class Dojo reward system across the school.
- ◆ Weekly awards e.g. values award, writer of the week.
- ◆ Termly attendance raffle.
- ◆ Annual awards e.g. ambassador, attendance.
- ◆ Early Birds and Late Owls (wrap around care).

For some children, including those needing some extra support we provide

Thinking, Understanding and Learning

- ◆ Maths support groups e.g. Success at Arithmetic, Talk for Number, First Class at Number, Springboard.
- ◆ English support groups e.g. small group spelling and/or phonics groups, Alien Club (phonics Year 1), Dandelion Reading scheme, Direct Phonics, Rapid Reading scheme, Totem and Talisman Reading schemes, visual discrimination skills, Talk for Writing, Pirate Writing.
- ◆ Year 6 SATs boosters.
- ◆ Daily readers.
- ◆ Memory boosters.
- ◆ Purbeck extension days e.g. maths, languages, music and drama.

- ◆ Talk Partners (YR)
- ◆ Time For Talk (KS1/2)
- ◆ Socially Speaking (KS2)
- ◆ Language for Thinking (All)
- ◆ Prefects (Y6)

Physical and Medical

- ◆ Gross and fine motor skills support e.g. Move to Learn, Take Ten
- ◆ Handwriting support e.g. Speed Up!, Handwriting Rescue Recovery Scheme, Patter Letters
- ◆ School Nurse for training on issues such as asthma and allergies requiring Epipen use
- ◆ Inter-school sports competitions.

Emotion and Behaviour

- ◆ Friendship and support groups (ELSA support)

For a few children, including those who need significant help in school we provide

Thinking, Understanding and Learning

- ◆ Support from Purbeck School to extend most able children.
- ◆ 1:1 dedicated Learning Support Assistants.
- ◆ Access to outside support:
 - Special Educational Needs Support Service (including the High Needs Block Team).
 - Dorset Reading Partners

Speech Language and Communication

- ◆ Access to outside support:
 - Speech & Language Therapy Service

Physical and Medical

- ◆ Support from outside Agencies:
 - Hearing and Vision Support Services
 - School Nurse
 - Paediatrician
 - Occupational Health Therapists
 - Physiotherapists
