FUN RUN TOTAL

We are absolutely delighted to inform that you have all raised a grand total of **£2,537.62** from the sponsored fun run. The total cost for the School Council's project will be approximately £28,000. The work will be split into 3 phases :

Phase 1: Track around the field so we can do a daily mile run.

Phase 2: Artificial surfacing on the area between the hall and the playground.

Phase 3: Jungle mulch surface extended from the musical instrument area along the fenced area under the trees.
