Physical Development (PD)

I will be learning to...

- explore movements with my body, moving safely with confidence and control
- develop my hand control through a range of fine motor activities using tweezers, scissors etc.
- hold my pencil correctly
- use a range of tools and equipment safely
- play group games
- play parachute games
- dance and express my ideas to music
- get dressed and undressed independently for PE

Mathematics (M)

I will be learning to....

- count, recognize and order numbers to at least 20
- say the number one more/less than a given number up to 20
- measure the height of plants using unifix
- count larger groups of objects in 2s and 10s
- combine two sets to find a total
- recognise symmetry in butterflies and ladybirds
- order leaves, plants and beanstalks according to size

Literacy (L)

I will be learning to...

- Practise and consolidate Phase 3 phonemes in my reading and writing: ai, ee, igh, oa, oo, oi, ow, ar, air, ear, er, ur, or, ure
- read a range of non-fiction books about growing, planting and life cycles
- write labels for the parts of a plant
- write draw simple instructions on seed packets
- sequence events from well-known stories
- use a word bank to help us re-tell simple stories
- talk about characters in story books
- explore the meaning of new vocabulary in our reading and story-telling

Personal Social Emotional Development (PSED)

I will be learning to...

- participate in turn taking games
- try new activities independently and select resources independently.
- think about the feelings of others and talk about being a good friend to others
- explore our school values and what they mean to us in Maple Class
- think about my family and special occasions and events we have shared

Communication and Language (CL)

I will be learning to...

- take part in whole class circle time, sharing my own experiences with others
- talk about why something happens and give reasons
- imagine and recreate roles of real life situations in role play and small world play
- ask questions to find out more information
