What we are learning this term:

This half-term our topic is all about 'Traders and Raiders' We will be studying the Anglo Saxon and Viking period looking particularly at what life was like for the Anglo Saxons, how they lived and where they came from. We will meet the Vikings as they begin to invade and sweep the land. We will explore Anglo Saxon arts and in English will travel back in time to work with Anglo Saxon and Viking myths and explore Anglo Saxon poetry.

After half term we will be studying a Science topic called 'Burps, Bottoms and Bile' As the title suggests this is all about the digestive system, teeth and eating.

In RE our topic is 'Creation' where we are exploring what it means to be made in the 'image and likeness of God' As the term progresses we then move onto the topic of 'Sacraments', 'Prayer, Saints and Feasts' and 'Advent'

YEAR 4 SLEEPOVER

This will take place on Friday 13th October starting at 6:30pm with the children being collected at 10am the following morning. The children will need to bring something to sleep on and in.

LIBRARY
