In each year group, this unit will include work on:

Year 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-identifying dangers, risks and hazards</li> <li>-strategies for managing risks</li> <li>-identifying people who they can ask for help to manage risks</li> <li>-online safety including safe sharing of information</li> <li>-strategies for managing dares</li> <li>-medicine safety and risks associated with smoking and alcohol</li> </ul>
Year 5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-exploring habits</li> <li>-identifying risks in decision making and strategies to deal with risky situations</li> </ul>
