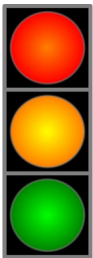

Remember the KS2 Cross country relay race and medal ceremony will take place on Tuesday 22nd May at Mullion Comprehensive School.

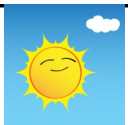
