## REMINDER ABOUT ILLNESS AND ABSENCE FROM SCHOOL

Please do not send your child to school if they, **or any member of your family who shares a home with them**, have any of the following symptoms:

- A high temperature.
- A new, continuous cough—this means coughing a lot more than an hour, or three or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual), ie not 3 single coughs.
- A loss or change to your sense or taste—this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal.

If you are concerned about Coronavirus and any symptoms that you, or your family may have, it might be useful to visit the following website using the link below and answer the questions—<https://111.nhs.uk/covid-19>. The current routes for getting a test are:

**A parent has advised the school that their experience has been that tests are more available when you request one early in the morning.**

If parents or carers are unable to book a local slot, then they can email [dccg.cornwalldevon.urgenttesting@nhs.net](mailto:dccg.cornwalldevon.urgenttesting@nhs.net) for advice, and will be assessed for urgent testing.

Please do not go to your GP or hospital emergency department to seek a test. If you are concerned about your child's symptoms ring 111. If you are not able to secure a test, it is important that your child remains away from school for the 10-day isolation period. As part of creating a COVID-19 safe school, children must not return before the isolation period is over.

If you have any questions or concerns about anything at school, in the first instant it is best to discuss this with your child's class teacher.
