Phonics

In June, the Y1 pupils will complete a statutory screening check to assess their progress in phonics and identify the need for any extra support. Further information for parents will be given near the time.

You can support your child at home by encouraging them to sound out unfamiliar words using their knowledge of both individual phonemes and also digraphs and trigraphs, where 2 or more letters create one sound (for example 'ar' as in farm and 'igh' as in sight)

The spellings that the children learn each week reinforce their phonics so please continue to support your child in reading and spelling the words they bring home.

Outdoor Clothes

Please make sure your child has a coat at school when rain is likely as we will try to venture out as much as possible. As the weather hopefully starts to improve, please also send in sun cream and sun hats when appropriate (all named please!).

PE/Swimming

The children will be doing PE with Mr Studd as usual on Tuesdays so PE kits can be worn to school every Tuesday for the duration of the term. Swimming will take place on Tuesday mornings and PE in the afternoon.

Navy blue School PE T-shirts can be bought at the school office and must be named please. School jumpers can be worn over this if needed. You can send your child to school in shorts or tracksuit.
