Mathematics

- Number - number and place value, ordinal numbers, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division, fractions
- Measurement, statistics and data

- Non-Fiction - Information texts, letter writing
- Poetry

Understanding the World

History and Geography: We will be learning about The Great Fire of London for the first half term. For the second half term we will learn about World War 1 which fits in with the Centenary.

Science: Children will be learning about Animals Including Humans.
