Week 4	Adding suffix -ly to words ending in l	carefully wonderfully painfully successfully beautifully peacefully faithfully accidentally cruelly especially finally totally usually coolly lethally
Week 5	/k/ with ch spelling	choir chemical ache chemist echo monarch orchid scheme stomach character mechanic school technology
