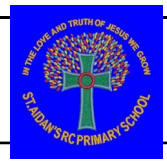

Absences

It is essential that if your child is absent from school you telephone the school office giving the reason for the absence. Please note that specific details are required and reporting him/her as just "unwell" is not sufficient.

If your child is suffering from sickness or has diarrhoea, **it must be 48hrs** from the last episode before they return to school.

Packed Lunches

Can we ask parent / carers to ensure that their children bring to school a packed lunch with **healthy** choices in. (No products containing nuts) Items must be

able to be opened independently as some children are having to wait a long time for staff to open cartons etc. Please remember no fizzy drinks and plastic bottles/containers only for drinks.

Jewellery

Our school prospectus is available on the school website, here is a reminder about jewellery:

Jewellery should not be worn to school, this also includes all types of earrings. Items such as earrings, necklaces, rings, bracelets etc. can cause injury to your child and the other children. It is also very upsetting for pupils if these items become lost or broken.

Safeguarding Updates

Just to keep you updated and ensure that safeguarding remains high on our agenda. Our safeguarding and e-safety policies were updated last term and can be accessed on the school website.

We've introduced a visitors' identification system and guidelines for all visitors' to adhere to whilst on site. Further details are available from the school office.

Just to flag up about mobile devices in school (further details in our E-Safety policy:

I-pads, i-watches and any mobile communication device which can access the internet and enable text messages, and any form of on-line communication are NOT allowed in school.

Pupils in Year 5 and Year 6 who travel to and from school independently are allowed to bring mobile phones into school. These must be switched off on entry onto the school grounds and handed into the school office.
