- Can you imagine what the characters in the story would be saying? Write in the speech bubbles

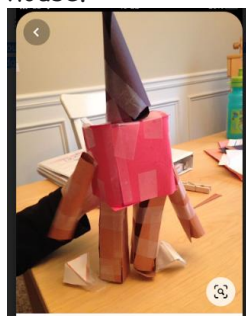
Mathematics

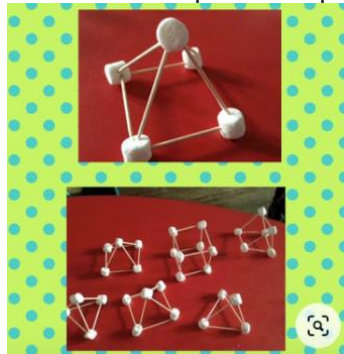
Here are some additional activities you might want to do:

- Can you create a superhero made out of 2D shapes? Which shapes did you use? How many sides altogether? How many corners altogether?
- Go on a 3D shape hunt around your house or outside. Can you name the shapes? Which 3D did you see the most of? You could even build a superhero using 3D shapes that you have found around your house.



- Using play dough and sticks (you could also use marshmallows and cocktail sticks). What 3D shapes can you make using these:

- 6 sticks and 4 pieces of play dough
- 12 sticks and 8 pieces of play dough
- 8 sticks and 5 pieces of play dough

- Can you make a 2D or 3D shape repeated pattern? Can someone in your house complete the pattern? Did they get it right?

Learn how to read and spell year 2 common exception words

- Can you create your own superhero identity? What would your super power be? You could create your own super hero costume.



- Who is your superhero? This could be your Mum, NHS workers. Who do you look up to? You could write them a letter to tell them that they are your superhero.

- Do superhero Science experiments such as supersize marshmallows, flying superheroes. You could write about your findings. I will upload these experiments.


