Mathematics

Our focus this week is fractions

- This week's fractions work is on adding and subtracting fractions, then some problem solving.

Here are some additional activities you might want to do:

- Continue to do Times Table Rockstars, see if you can move up a level!
- Split food such as an apple, orange, chocolate bar or a pizza into different pieces. Can you then use this to practice adding and subtracting fractions?
- Can you use objects around your house like rice, pasta or pencils to find fractions of amounts. If you have 30 pencils, you can put them into 5 different groups to find $\frac{2}{5}$. Try this with different fractions and different amounts too!


