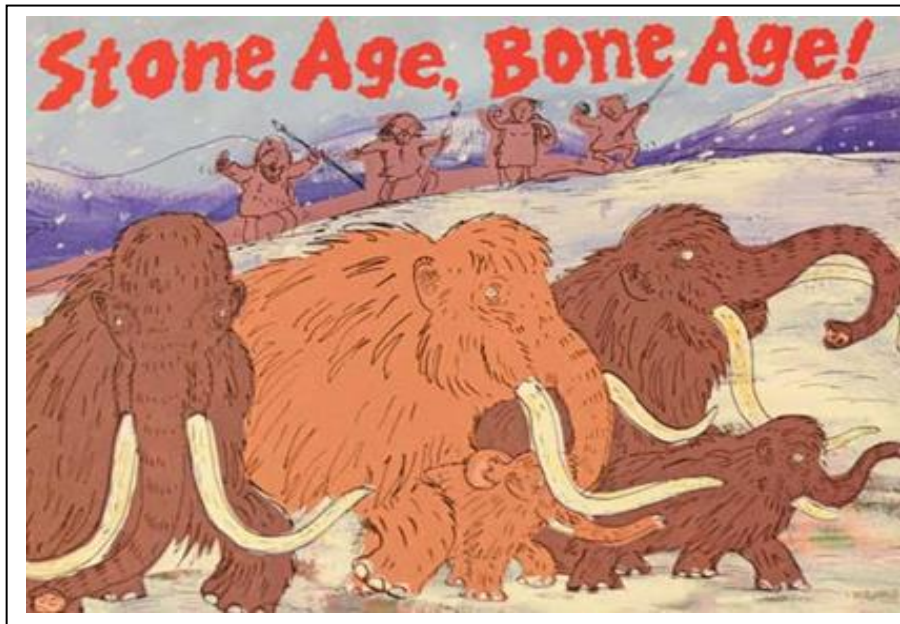
Humans and other animals
