New Early Years Unit and Little Learners Environment

In the October holidays we will be changing our Early Years Unit around, after following advice from Northumberland Early Years Consultants. The old Little Learners and Nursery classroom will be linked together for Reception/Nursery to be in the same classroom. This is to ensure more opportunities for independence, creativity, and peer learning. The children will be put into 3 'family groups' (with an adult) to plan, do and review their learning each day. You will drop the children off and collect them from their family carpet. Little Learners will move into the reception classroom to ensure quality outside play and they will have an interactive whiteboard to help aid speaking and listening skills occasionally, especially by discussing photographs of them self on the board to their class. The entrance will have a lending library of books and toys. You can borrow one item for a week. We are all very excited and appreciate your on going support.
