

Science

Identify a range of objects and the materials they are made from.

Describe the properties of materials and use these to classify materials into groups.

Compare and contrast an object made from different materials in terms of its effectiveness.

Select and justify materials for a particular use based on suitability and limitations of the materials.

English

Writing: look more closely at the use of tenses within writing, ensuring they are consistent across each piece of written work; use adverbs of time to sequence writing; using capital letters for proper nouns; ongoing focus on sentence punctuation. Write advertisements, poetry, letters, diaries and story sequels.

Handwriting: focus on size of writing and using simple joins in Year 1; use neat joined handwriting in Year 2.

Reading: using known sounds to decode a range of texts; finding information within a text; comprehension to focus on prediction, inference and comparing texts.

Maths

Multiplication and division: Count in 2s, 5s, 10s and 3s; recognise odd and even numbers; solve problems involving \times and \div by using concrete objects, pictorial representations and arrays; write number sentences using \times , \div and $=$.

Length and height: Measure and record lengths and heights; use appropriate units to measure; solve practical problems for lengths and heights.

PSHE

Take part in topical discussions and debates, developing speaking and listening skills.

Learn how to express own opinions while respecting the views of others.

Discuss different feelings and how best to deal with these feelings.
