

# Writing your Winter Poem

Yesterday, you brainstormed ideas about what winter would be like if he or she was a person. Today you are going to turn those ideas into a poem.



- You need to use figurative language- similes and metaphors, to conjure up a good picture.

- You can use alliteration.

- Use a rhyme scheme- how often will lines rhyme?

- Write in separate stanzas (verses)

# Make a plan

How many stanzas?

What will be in each stanza? e.g.

**Stanza 1-** What Winter looks like

**Stanza 2-** Winter's personality

**Stanza 3-** what winter does, hobbies  
etc.

Your poem could be a story- a narrative poem- telling the reader a story about something winter did or does.
