Learning Achievements

Reception:

Class 1: This week we have been busy working on writing our retell of "The Three Little Pigs" and researching about big cats around the world. In Maths we have been working on representing numbers using place value charts and part whole models and recognising one more than a number. We have had lots of fun baking biscuits for our coffee morning.

Class 2: this week the children have been finding factors, completing empty number line, column addition and subtraction. In English they have been writing a diary entry as either Icarus or his father Daedalus. Their diary needed to include a hypothetical question.

In RE this week the children have looked at how different Christian groups celebrate God and creation. They have analysed different texts and made links between what different groups do. In topic, they have developed their understanding of life in Ancient Greece by researching the differences between the rich and poor. They have looked at the difference between diet, clothes, family, housing and work, and thought about what it might have been like to be a slave for a wealthy family. They have had a lot of fun putting their baking skills to the test; they worked in groups to make a selection of chocolate and banana muffins for the Macmillan coffee morning.
