Learning Achievements

Reception: have been learning to play some new instruments and learning all about what an orchestra is. In Maths they have been looking at taking away problems. They have also had fun making pizzas with KS1.

Class 1: have been looking at properties of dough by making pizzas and writing instructions for this. They have looked at writing character descriptions from George's Marvellous Medicine. In Maths they have been solving problems linked to length and height.

Class 2: have been travelling to Berlin! They have seen all the sights the city has to offer and with this new found knowledge of the city the children have sent an email back home. Shadows featured in our science lesson with the children carrying out their own investigation using a light source and an object of their choice to create different shadows.
