There are no scooters, bikes, wheeled toys or wheeled footwear permitted to be ridden or used on the yard. Children have been advised of the sanctions if they are observed breaking this important Health and Safety rule.

Can we also remind all adults transporting children to and from school, to park respectfully. We have very good relationships with our residential neighbours and want these to continue.



Important Weather Information

Although the weather appears to be heading to improve and get a little warmer, as you will no doubt have realised yourself in the most recent weeks, sometimes the forecasts get it entirely wrong! With this in mind, please can we ask that **ALL** children have a waterproof warm coat, waterproof boots, hat and gloves in school. Where possible we will always endeavour to get the children outside at playtime/dinnertime. However, should your child not be suitably attired for the weather they **WILL NOT** be given the opportunity (should it arise) to go outside. Please also be aware that school communal areas can get cold during temperature drops, so all children will need a sweatshirt or cardigan to wear whilst in school. We are expecting children to wear trousers or thick tights with skirts - no summer dresses or shorts should be worn when temperatures are low.

6 of our most able gymnasts took part in an inter-schools gymnastics event at Northern Gymnastics Centre, Cramlington on Thursday 7th February.

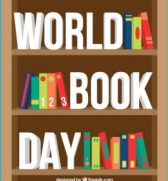
They performed exceptionally well and were (as always) a credit to the school.
