## Remote Learning

Dear Parents and Carers,

As you are now aware we have moved to online learning for those children who are unable to physically attend school.

It is now a legal requirement for children to be able to access high quality remote learning. The best way we can offer this is to allow children to be a part of the lessons being delivered in school. This way they will hopefully feel like they are in touch with what is going on in the building and be able to communicate with classroom staff.

The expectation is that your child /children will log in for registration in the morning and again in the afternoon.

All children will receive a learning pack on a Friday afternoon, (you will receive a message asking you to come and collect it from school). This will contain both paper based worksheets that will link directly to daily online classroom sessions and instruction sheets for those activities that are timetabled for children to complete independently. Please do not allow your child to have access to this pack before the sessions take place. A pencil has been included for them to use. Do not let them use anything else on these sheets.

Please return the week's completed learning in the zip wallet each Friday when you come to pick up your next pack/s.

Whilst we always aim to provide the very highest quality learning experiences we are aware that delivering this remotely has presented a number of challenges for both us and you too. It is inevitable that there will be a few more teething problems along the way as we all get used to this way of the children accessing learning. Thank you very much for your enthusiasm and support this far, you've done an amazing job supporting your children to access their learning.

I know some of you have had problems with the internet connection and speed where multiple devices are being used at the same time within your household. If you are experiencing difficulties it would really help if you could contact your broadband provider and point out the issues you are having and ask them to offer help
