



Whalton's Pupil Premium Grant Allocation 2018-19

6 children - £7,860

Main barriers to educational achievement faced by eligible pupils at Whalton

- Speech, Language and Communication
- Gross and fine motor skills
- Social and emotional well being
- Lack of enrichment opportunity
- Literacy and Numeracy skills

Expenditure of pupil premium to overcome barriers

- Staffing for additional 1:1 or group sessions
- Funding of a specialist speech and language therapist
- Buying into the SEND Services @£360 per day (Educational Psychologist, Behaviour and ASD Team, Speech and Language Team and Literacy Team)
- Buying in support from an Occupational Therapist
- Educational support and resources linked to their needs e.g. music lessons, educational visits, resources

Measuring the impact of the Pupil Premium Funding

- Statutory assessments (assessment moderation, national tests)
- Pen Portraits (for smaller steps progress)
- Teacher Assessment Meetings with team of staff
- Data analysis and monitoring and review of trends
