The Pupil Premium Grant (PPG) The grant is used for the educational benefit of pupils registered at either Longhorsley or Whalton C of E Schools.

We are required to publish how much Pupil Premium money we receive and how we have chosen to spend that money. The following list is a summary of this information:

Training for staff:

All staff have all been trained in Growth Mindset, Precision Monitoring and Lego Therapy. (£540 whole Federation)

We buy into Northumberland County Council SEND Team, so if any of the children have additional needs we can buy days from their services in Speech and Language, Literacy, Educational Psychology and the ASD and Behaviour Team, if pre booked at a cost of £360 per day, or a higher rate of £420 per day.

Some of the children have received early morning sessions as a booster program, delivered by a teaching assistant from 8.30 -9.00 am. These sessions are for a period of a minimum of 4 weeks and are repeated a minimum of termly and between 3 and 5 days per week, some children have received this daily for the full year. (£180 per pupil up to £1387.50), per year identified as needing such support.

Weekly Homework Club has been established at Whalton, to help those who have been unable to complete their tasks at home. (£555)

SENDCo release time 1 day per half term, per school to look at how to best target our pupils. Analysis of data, scrutiny of pen portraits created by the class teacher and 1:1 meetings with staff/teaching assistants to review targets. (£1260 per school)

Intervention programs (1:1 Read, Write Inc, or targeted reading tasks 1:1 (daily) - annual cost £1387.50 per year. Occupational Therapy (3 x per week) - annual cost - £832.50, 1:2 or 1:4 Nurture Groups (1 x per week) - annual cost £277.50, spelling support 1:1 (3 x per week) annual cost - £832.50 per pupil. Children may also receive 1:1 or small group support, delivered by our Teaching Assistants and monitored by the class teachers.

School Breakfast/After school costs: Provision and uptake varies £12 per half term for 1 hour clubs at Longhorsley. Whalton - Breakfast and After School is open daily at a cost of £4.50 per hour.

Residential Visits in Year 4, 5 and 6 at Whalton (at varying costs but for this academic year £150 per pupil- Year 4 and Year 5 - No Year 6's currently until 18-19)

Residential Visits in Year 4 at Longhorsley. At a cost of £150 per child.

Ipads - for shared work on apps from Spelling Bee, OT Road. (3 ipads purchased per school at a cost of £957 per school)

Uniform for Families in Need - Longhorsley: £60.20 + sports/school shoes if deemed appropriate

Whalton: £88.32 + sports/school shoes if deemed appropriate

Please Note: Some children have additional tuition and extra curricular opportunities outside of school, for example, Gymnastic specialist coaching and musical tuition (cost up to £200 per pupil)
