



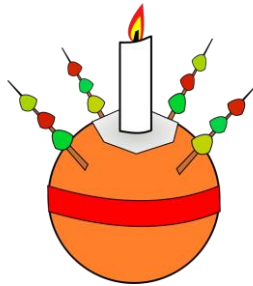
RE Ambassadors' Newsletter 9 Autumn 2020
