In the meantime, we would like to pass on our continued thanks for your patience and understanding at this tricky time.

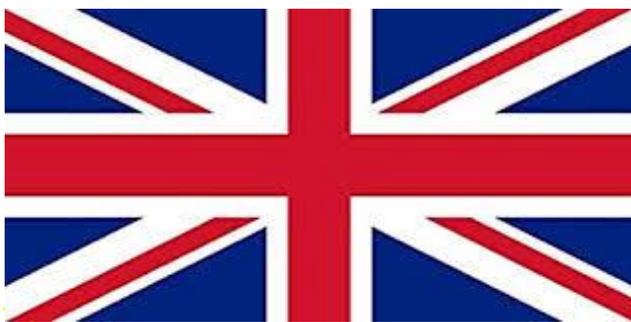
### Home Learning
