Remote Learning using Google Classroom

In the event that a class bubble may have to self-isolate at home, the class teacher will now be setting any school work online using Google Classroom. This is an online learning tool that allows children to access and submit their work to be marked by the teacher. Google Classroom is now being used across the Trust for home learning and for work within lessons. We hope to be able to also use it in our Year 3 and 4 class during the school day and to set homework.

On the school website, under the Curriculum, Remote Learning heading, you will find a useful video that will explain the use of Google Classroom to you. The school's Remote Learning Policy and Plan are also on the website so please take the time to read through both documents.

Your child's login details to access Google Classroom have been stuck into the front of their green diary.

Google Classroom app

1. Install the Google Classroom app onto your device.
2. Open the app on your device.
3. Enter your child's school email and password.
4. They should now have access to their virtual classroom.

Google Classroom using a web browser

1. Open the web browser on the device your child will be using and go onto google (if you have Gmail already we advise using the "incognito" function when using the browser).
2. Select 'sign in' in the top right corner.
3. Enter your child's school email and password.
4. Click on the 9 dots that make a square in the top right hand corner.
5. Select 'Classroom' and this should take you to the virtual classroom.

I would appreciate it if you could aim to login to your child's account by the end of next week so we can get an idea of who is able to access Google Classroom. If you have any further questions, please don't hesitate to ask.
